

USATF 2019 ANNUAL MEETING
MEN'S TRACK AND FIELD COMMITTEE REPORT

Records: The records committee of USATF is considering a process for ratifying records between annual meetings. The records committee is considering two ratification periods between annual meetings each year, one at the end of indoor season and one at the end of outdoor season.

Team Reports: The Men's World Championship team in Doha, Qatar in 2019 won nine and half gold medals (half in the mixed 4x400 meter relay), five silver medals and one bronze medal. Donovan Brazier set a new American Record in winning a gold medal in the 800 meters. The mixed 4x400 meter relay with two women and two men set a world record in the preliminary round and again in the finals with 4 different athletes (two women and two men).

At the World Athletics Relays in Japan in 2019, the USA men won five gold medals and two silver medals. The full USA team won the Golden Baton.

At the North America, Central America, Caribbean (NACAC) Under 23 Championships in 2019, the USA won 57 total medals including women and men. At the Under 20 Pan American Games in Costa Rica in 2019, the USA won 50 total medals including women and men, and set three Under 20 world records.

USATF plans to conduct the Olympic Trials at Hayward Field in Eugene, Oregon in June of 2020 to select the Olympic Team for the 2020 Olympic Games in Tokyo, Japan.
