Coach Appointment Scoring System Discussion- Proposed system presented by Curtis Frye

Proposal- Youth \$21.90 and Adult \$32.85

Coach Appointment Scoring System- Proposal

Purpose: To establish an objective scoring system to identify and rank track and field coaches for selection for national track and field team coaching positions.

- Currently, coach selection is based on nominations and subjective system.
- Scoring system would provide a selection pool of qualified applicants for International/Olympic Coach Appointment.

Registry Coaches –2700 applied, 2500 approved, 300 denied,

400 grandfathered (experience, years and international)

Three types of Levels- L1, L2 and L3
