### ***2020 Outdoor Track and Field Season Launches with 2019 Grand Prix Awards***

The Ohio Association of USA Track & Field, the National Governing Body of our sport in the United States, is looking forward with great excitement and anticipation to the 2020 outdoor track and field season. As we launch the 2020 season, let's take a quick look back at 2019 and recognize the 2019 Ohio Association Grand Prix Awardees.

The USA Track & Field Ohio Association Grand Prix is an annual series of track and field meets where every competitor placing in the top eight in his or her event in each meet in the series scores points. Points scored in each of the Grand Prix series meets are totaled at the end of the season. The top three points scorers in each of eight age/gender divisions receive Grand Prix Awards. The individual achieving the high aggregate score during the season also receives the Grand Champion Award.
